The proposed Chappelle Project is considered to be a small mine which would have a small environmental impact, thus no further stage reports will be requested. The company will be required to meet all the requirements of government agencies.

The one major impact in the area will be access to the proposed extension of the Omineca Road. The mine cannot be considered unless there is road access to the mine and therefore is dependent on the proposed extension. The Ministry of Mines and Petroleum Resources proposes to extend the Omineca Road in 1978 and have been in contact with the Regional Fish and Wildlife representative, Parks, and Forestry in this regard. Mr. P.E. Olson, P.Eng., Senior Inspector - Roads and Trails, is in charge of the Omineca Road.
