Jimo Claims

Seven copper showings, found in 1974, were examined in detail last summer (see Figure 6). All showings except one are small occurrences of bornite and/or chalcocite on joints in coarse grained andesite porphyry. Most showings are associated with east-west striking faults or dykes similar to the faults and dykes on the western part of the Claw.

The one exception is Showing No. 2. This showing is in altered coarse to medium grained andesite. Sulphides are chalcocite, bornite, pyrite and chalcopyrite. This mineralization is exposed along twelve feet on top of a talus slope and extends approximately 30 feet vertically up a cliff. A chip sample assayed 0.38% Cu and 0.64 oz/ton Ag over 12 feet. This altered, fractured andesite is similar to the altered pyrite zones found in Hole CL-3 on the Claw in 1975.

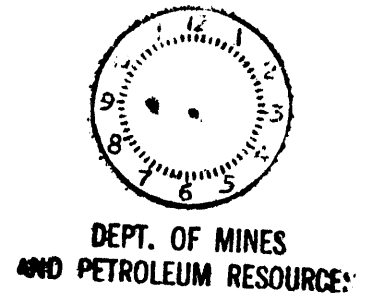
