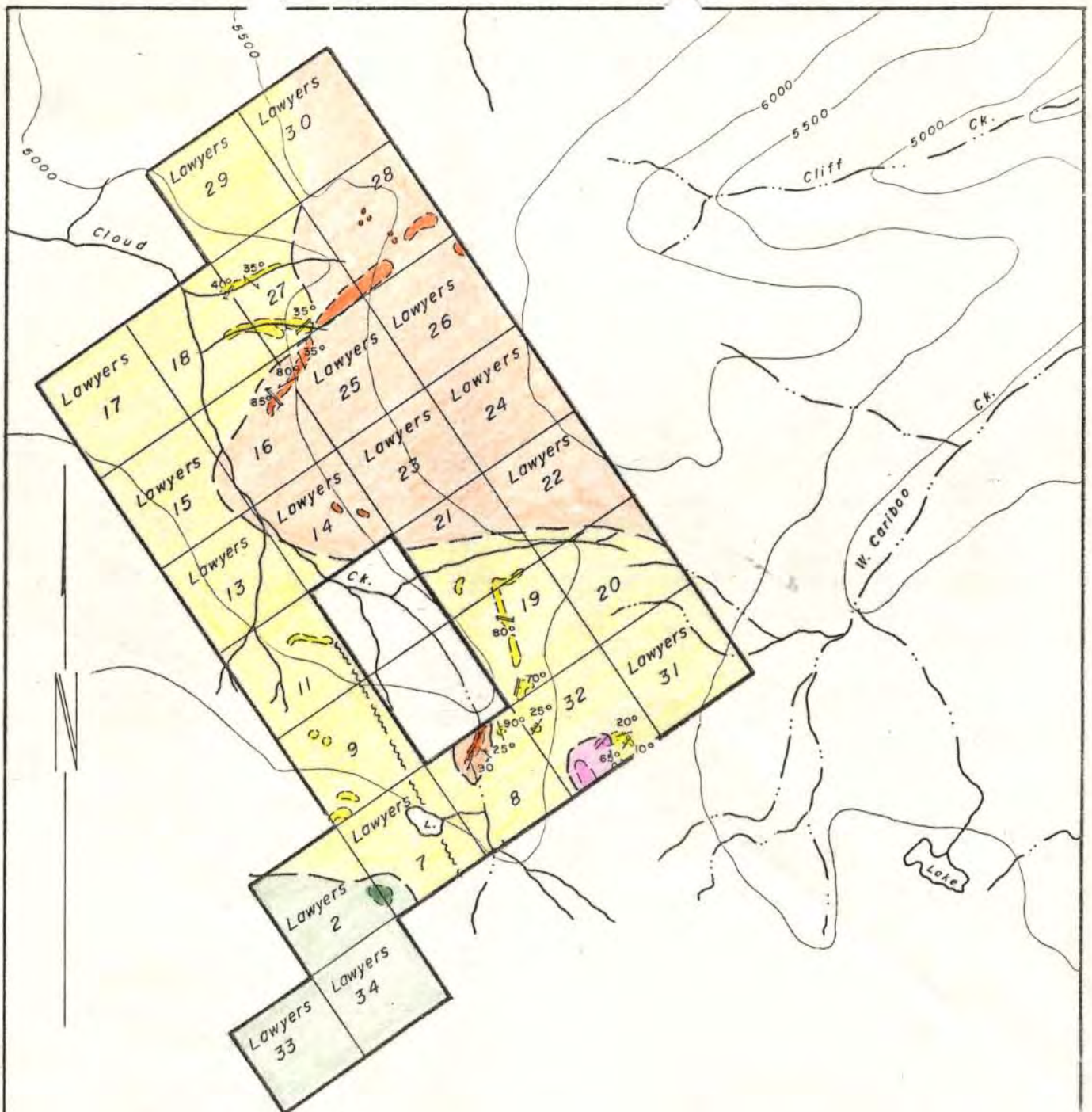

Quartz - pebble, conglomerates & sandstones

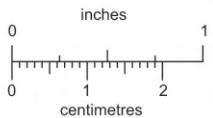
JURASSIC or YOUNGER
