The George Cross News Letter of August 27, No. 166 (1962) refers to information from Silver Standard Mines Limited on the <u>Iron Duke</u> property. Based on some 30 holes drilled by Silver Standard, and 15 holes drilled earlier, reserves are calculated at 515,000 tons grading 45 per cent iron, plus an additional 100,000 tons of probable ore, limit> in extent to within the anomolous area, and in depth by flat lying intrusives, are said to have been demonstrated.

The foregoing was probably known to you.

Inclusion in your notes (lode metals 1961) on the Tassoo, and Harriet Harbour properties, of information on quantity, grade, and impurities, where available, is a very useful feature.
