

Re: Char Mining Claims - Skeena M.D., B.C.

Pursuant to Section 52(2)(b) of the Mineral Act on submitting a report of the exploration and development carried out on a mineral claim that has been abandoned or allowed to lapse, I hereby advise you of our forfeiture of the Char claims, located north of Cumshewa Inlet on May 3 and May 30, 1975 [see attached claim schedule].

The exploration work carried out in 1974 consisted of detailed silt sampling, mapping and prospecting in and around the Char claims. One hundred and seventy-three silt samples were collected and analysed by the Atomic Absorption method for Cu, Pb, Zn, Mo, Ag, Ni, Co, Au and As. Geology and sample data were plotted on a commercially prepared 1:12,000 scale topographic base map.

Enclosed is a map showing all sample locations.

I trust this meets with the necessary requirements of Section 52(2)(b) of the Mineral Act.
