Dear Mr. Kiddie,

I visited Bellingham today and in an interview with Mr. W. J. Hughes Secy for the Gibbell Island Copper Company which has been opening up a property on Gibbell Island B. C. was informed that he would favorably consider a proposition to lease that property for 5 years. - I suggested that I would submit a proposal to you on the following terms: - Ninety days option to consider the advisability of taking a lease, with the privilege of entering on the property and doing any prospecting work considered desirable, and that the lease should permit of shipping all ore on the following terms: - A royalty of 4% on all ore carrying less than \$8.00 per ton gross  
5% " " " " " from 8.00 to 10.00  
6% " " " " " " 10.00 to 12.00

and the royalty to increase proportionately with increase in values. - The ore from samples drawn is principally bornite in a siliceous gangue, and the Secy informed me the following development work had been done: - Three tunnels one 3.5 ft. long, another 26.5 ft, the third 200 ft, and a shaft sunk in ore 30 feet deep. - The outcrop is the same from 20 to 40 ft. wide and can be traced through the length of 8 claims. - The main workings are 600 ft above sea level, and a tramway to a cove harbor and deep water would require to be about from 1200 to 1500 ft long. - There are 13 claims in the group. - The Company will consider the proposition and write you. -
