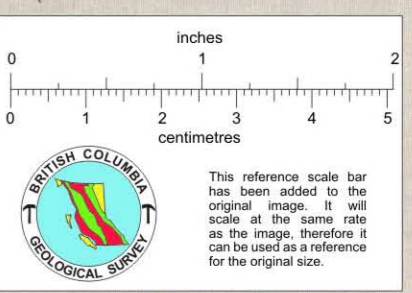


Buccaneer of the North.

Area enclosed by red line is approximate but is probably extensively underlain by the lime deposit, the depth of which is as yet unknown. No glacial debris overlies this area which consists of gently-sloping ground, and in which the lime deposit is immediately overlain by moss and timber. A material tonnage is indicated as being available for shipment on completion of road from Ritchie. Small and shallow pits indicate that the meadow is probably entirely underlain by the lime deposit, but this area is water-logged, and seasonally entirely flooded, whereas the area enclosed by red line lies entirely above water level, and rises gently from edge of meadow to a maximum elevation of 25 to 30 feet above the latter.
