Johnson's Knolls

Porphyry Dyke.
No money found above where Porphyry dyke crosses creek.

Biddle Bench - Bedrock 10' above creek (600,000 acre feet).
229' Drop from ditch to top of Bedrock.

Roosevelt Creek - Bedrock 20' above creek.
(1,000,000 acre feet)

279' Drop from ditch to old channel

Famous California Bar has produced over \$300,000.

Ungherini Creek - Bedrock 25' above creek (1,000,000 acre feet)

400' Drop.

Small Butte. 200' above creek.
Note. Granted for tailing purposes.

300' Flume 144' high

Arrowwood Bench - Bedrock 30' above creek (750,000 acre feet).
Falls in creek 20'

Ditch Drops 25' into dry lake saving ditching.

Buck's old workings. \$38,900 off of 41,000 acre feet of bedrock.

Fleming Creek - Bedrock 30' above creek (600,000 acre feet)

\$10,000 taken from 144 Acre feet.

McCarty Mountain

150' Flume 30' high

100,000 acre feet worked by old miners.

Foster bench - Bedrock 35' above creek (600,000 acre feet)

Lone Star Creek - Bedrock 35' above creek (500,000 acre feet)

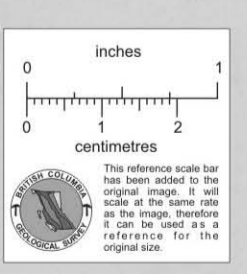
6300 miners inches at this point.
