Further to our recent telephone conversation regarding old surface workings at McDame Lake, I did some searching and discovered that the NORA claim was located by John Vollaug in November 1940. It is described as being immediately south of the outlet of McDame Lake. In April 1943, the claim was sold to Gerry Davis who subsequently sold a 25% interest to W. O. Harper of Dawson Creek. This claim has been grouped with others as the McDame group and is in good standing, still held by Gerry Davis, until 1974. In 1944, Gerry mined about 40 tons of quartz ore and in a small amalgamator recovered about 40 ounces of gold. There is no further record of gold being recovered.
