

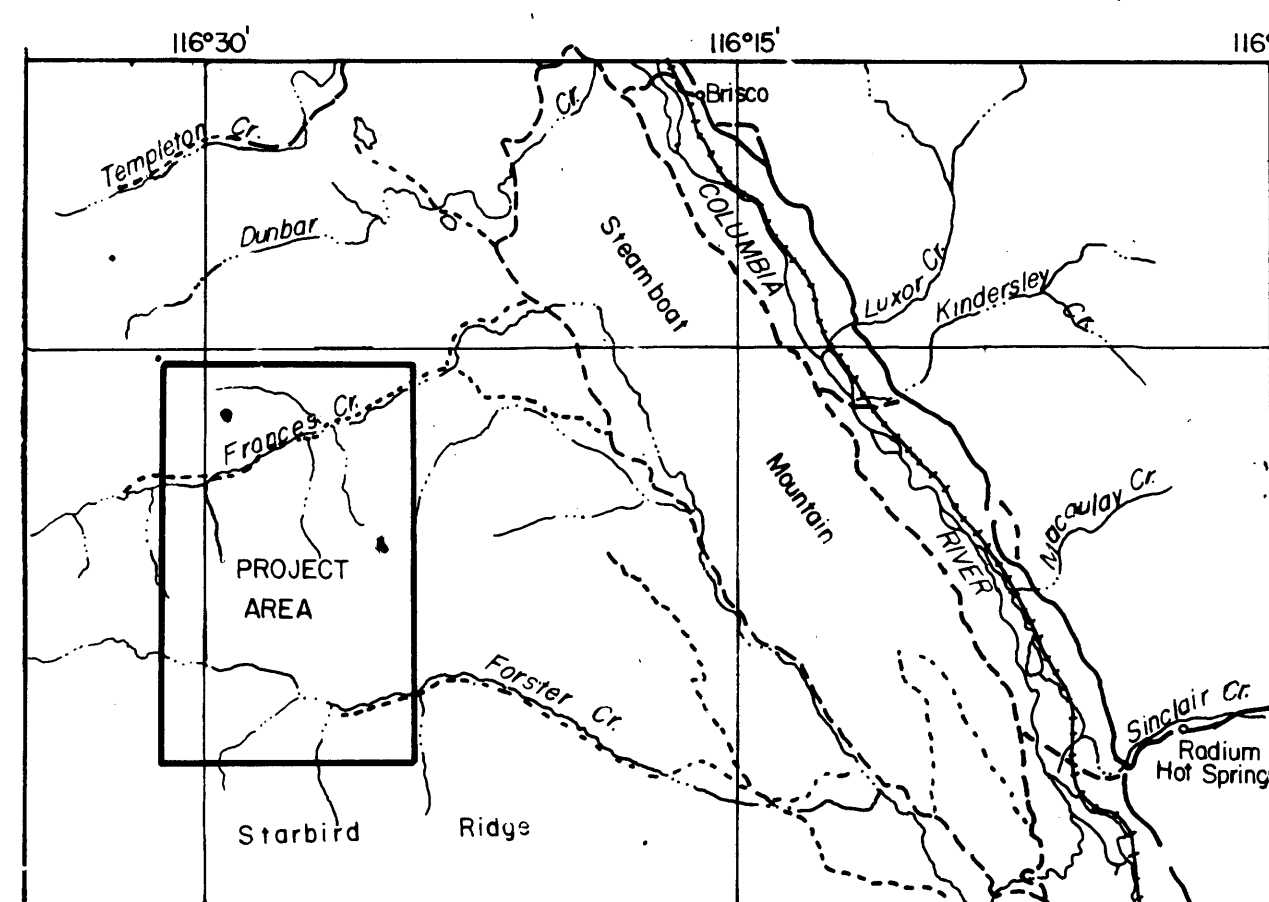
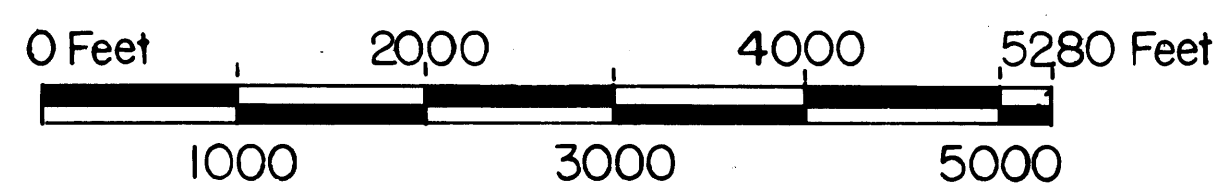
GEOLOGIC SYMBOLS

- Key-bed or bedding trace
- Fault, fracture or joint (Defined, interpreted)
- Thrust fault
- Anticline (Normal, overturned)
- Syncline (Normal, overturned)
- Attitude of bedding
- Attitude of plane of fault fracture or joint (Normal, vertical, overturned)
- Attitude of plane of thrust fault (With or without degrees of dip)
- Quaternary overburden and dense forest cover
- Permanent ice or snow

MAP COLOURS Colours other than Q or Qs are here used to accentuate the correlation of various rock increments between thrust faults or fault splinters
