Dear Mr McCammon,

During a recent visit to British Columbia I visited the B.C and Yukon Chamber of Mines to discuss with Mr Tom Elliott the potential availability of non-metallic minerals - chiefly zircon and magnesite. Mr Elliott was able to give some information but suggested that I should contact you with regard to magnesite deposits.

Whilst in Victoria, I telephoned your Department and spoke with Dr Holland, who told me that you had information on your files and could supply details of known deposits, locations and owners that I could follow up. He also explained that you were away on a field trip and that I should write requesting the above information, which I now do.

My interest is chiefly in high grade material, low in sesqui-oxides and with lime and silica below about 3% total, suitable for use in basic oxygen steelmaking furnaces. However, I don't suppose you have detailed analyses in most cases, so it will be sufficient just to have the contact addresses where these are available.

I am sorry that we were not able to meet since I could have shown you samples, with chemical and mineralogical assessment
