Dear John Brock,

Our primary goal is to develop the "Pretty Rock Company" (Indigenous Species) for cash and barter trade (PRC = China). The logic of barter trade is to move volume where cash is not possible. Several years have been spent making contacts.

The meat and potatoes is BC Nephrite Jade. Management and marketing are in place.

PHASE 1 - Vancouver to Lillooet to Lytton to Kwoiek Creek (Jade and Vesuvianite) to Vancouver with stops.

Itinerary (Pre Feasability)

Day 1 - Vancouver to D'Arcy - restake and assess Nephrite showing.

Day 2 - 4 - 4\*4 and Barry Price to Hell Creek Jade (owner J. McDonald) to assess Jade on dump, in Talus and to assess the open cut mining of 200 mt in place Jade. Vein is traceable for 800 m and is 2.3 m wide. Previous production was 100 mt. Current access is 22 Km from Lillooet to the Yalakom River then by logging road to the Jade showing. 1993 mining should consume only 20 m of vein. A 1.6 m Talc vein adjacent to the Jade is potentially saleable to Quadra Stone and others (\$800/mt)

A report and video would be produced and approx 400 Kg of material as samples.

Day 4 Barry Price returns to Vancouver.

Costs - report, 4\*4 (B.Price), groc, bags assay, filing work, video tape and reproductions, storage, equipment (small), food for jeweller, gas for 2 wheel truck, \$ 4,000.

Day 5 - 7 - Jim and jeweller (George) to Lytton to prospect for Jadeite (2nd try).

Day 8 - 11 - Kwoiek Creek by road and climbing to Jade and Vesuvianite showing to Video and collect samples and to assess extraction of 10-20 tons of Vesuvianite (Idocrase). Barry Price was previously on the property and has written a report. The value of Vesuvianite is similar to BC Jade. All side creeks along Kwoiek Cr. will be panned and silt samples will be assayed for PGE.

Cost of report and update should be low (\$500).

Costs - Lillooet to Lytton to Kwoeik Cr to Vancouver with 2 stops. 8 days total including report, samples, cutting samples, report, etc is \$3,000. There are no wages for the jeweller.

The total costs of for both property assessments and reports is \$7,000. The additional days are at expenses only and are to stake and assess other showings. These two showings are the only ones with significant production and quality histories. Other Jade showings are in difficult and dangerous locals.



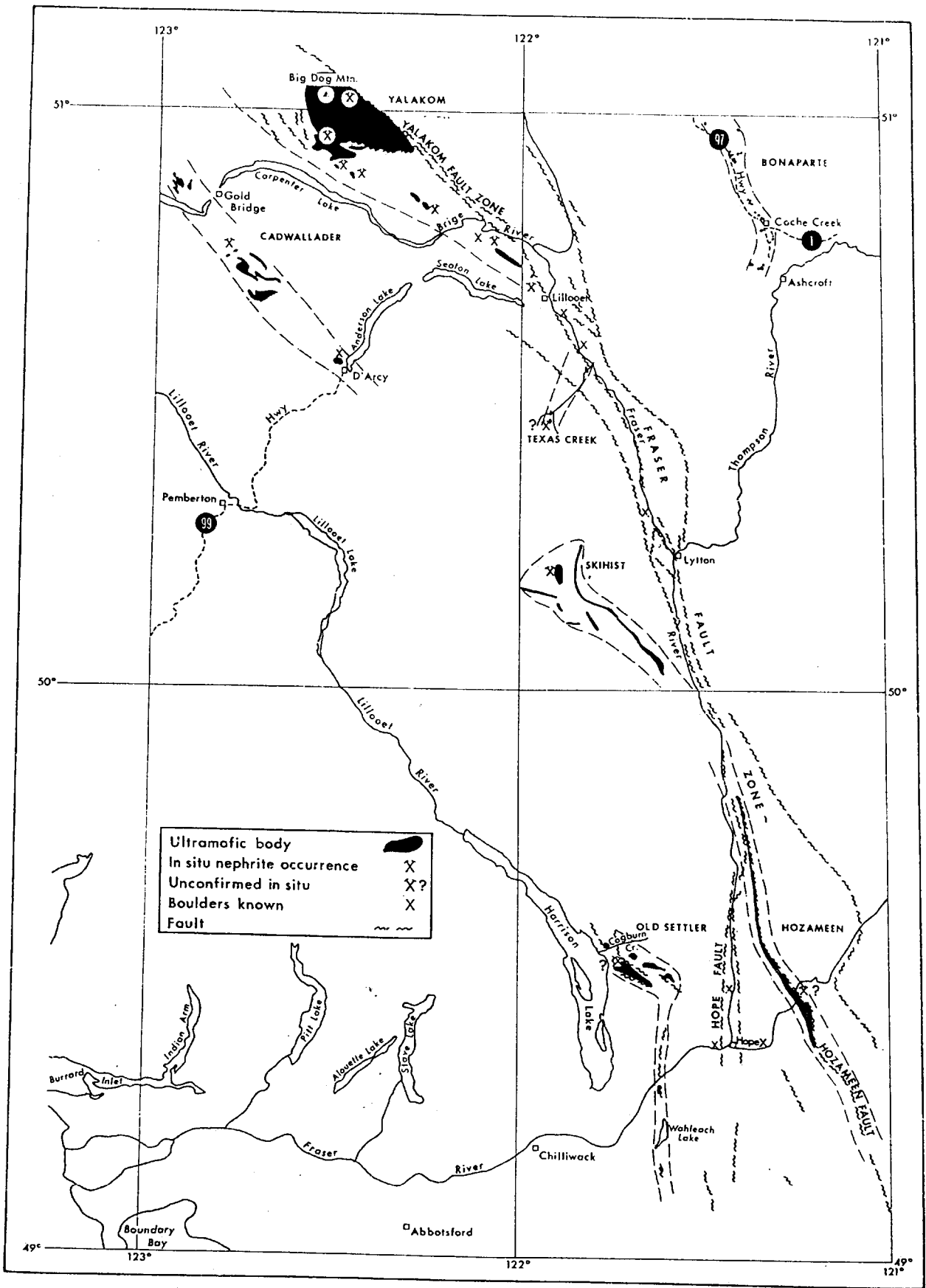


Figure 8. Nephrite deposits Lillooet segment.

Dear Sir,

Following is our plan for the Jade vein on the Yak 3 & 4.

1 JUN 93 we plan a property assessment, examine the layout of the showing of the Jade & 1.3m Talc vein for extraction and for a geological report. Silt and soil samples for PGE.

15 - 30 JUN 93 we plan a preliminary extraction of stockpile and talus and loose rock by dump truck (13 mt).

As for the vein itself we plan to cut blocks of Talc by hand tools. The Jade vein itself was previously mined by underground methods. Our plan is to simply blast away the sidewall where feasible and disperse the waste in an acceptable manner across the glacial debris. The vein itself is fractured and the Jade will be extracted using a ripper or pick on a backhoe. Our final choice of machinery will be 6 weeks off.

The reclamation will be the dispersal of material to conform with the local terrain and will be done before the Jade can be extracted.

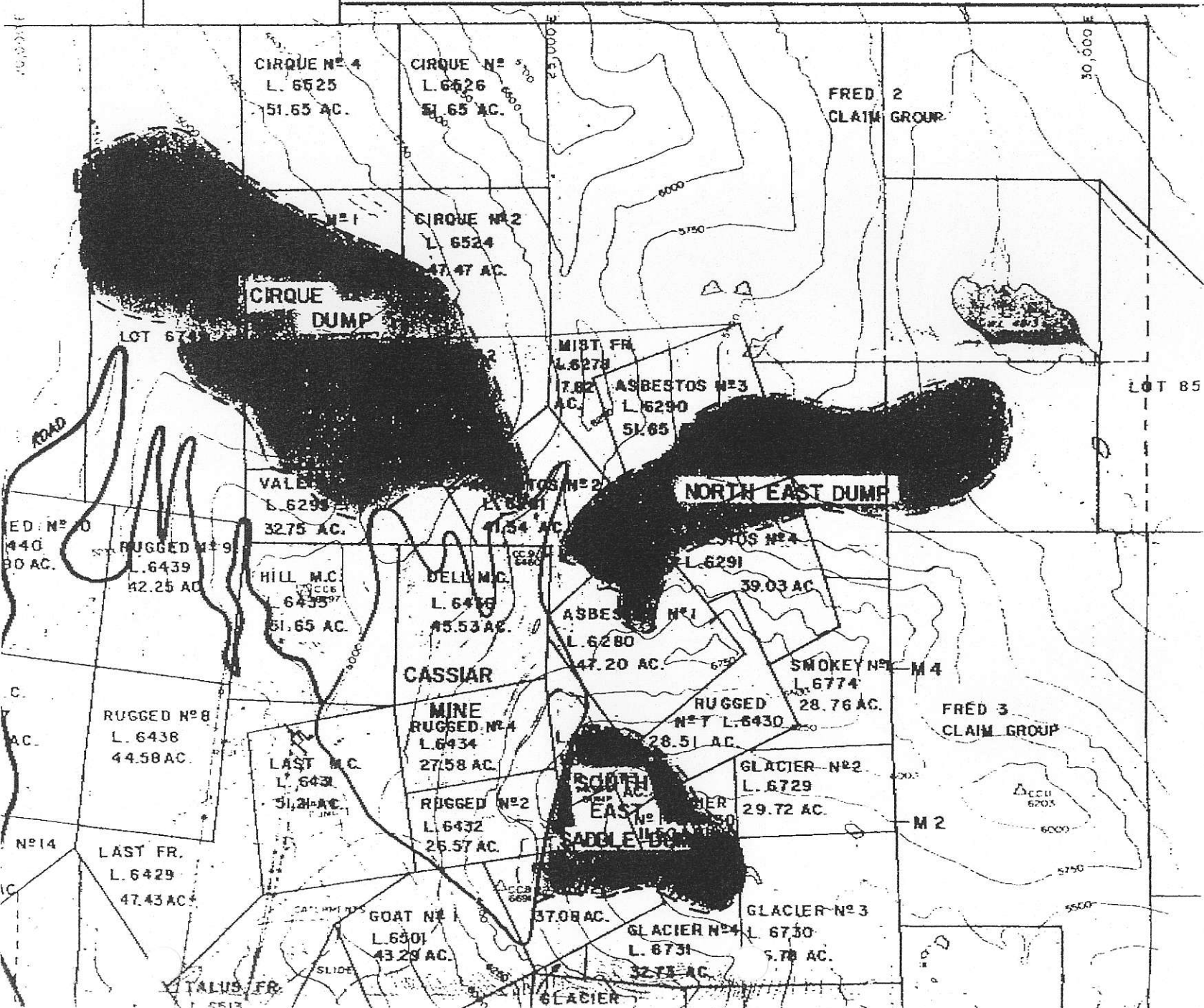
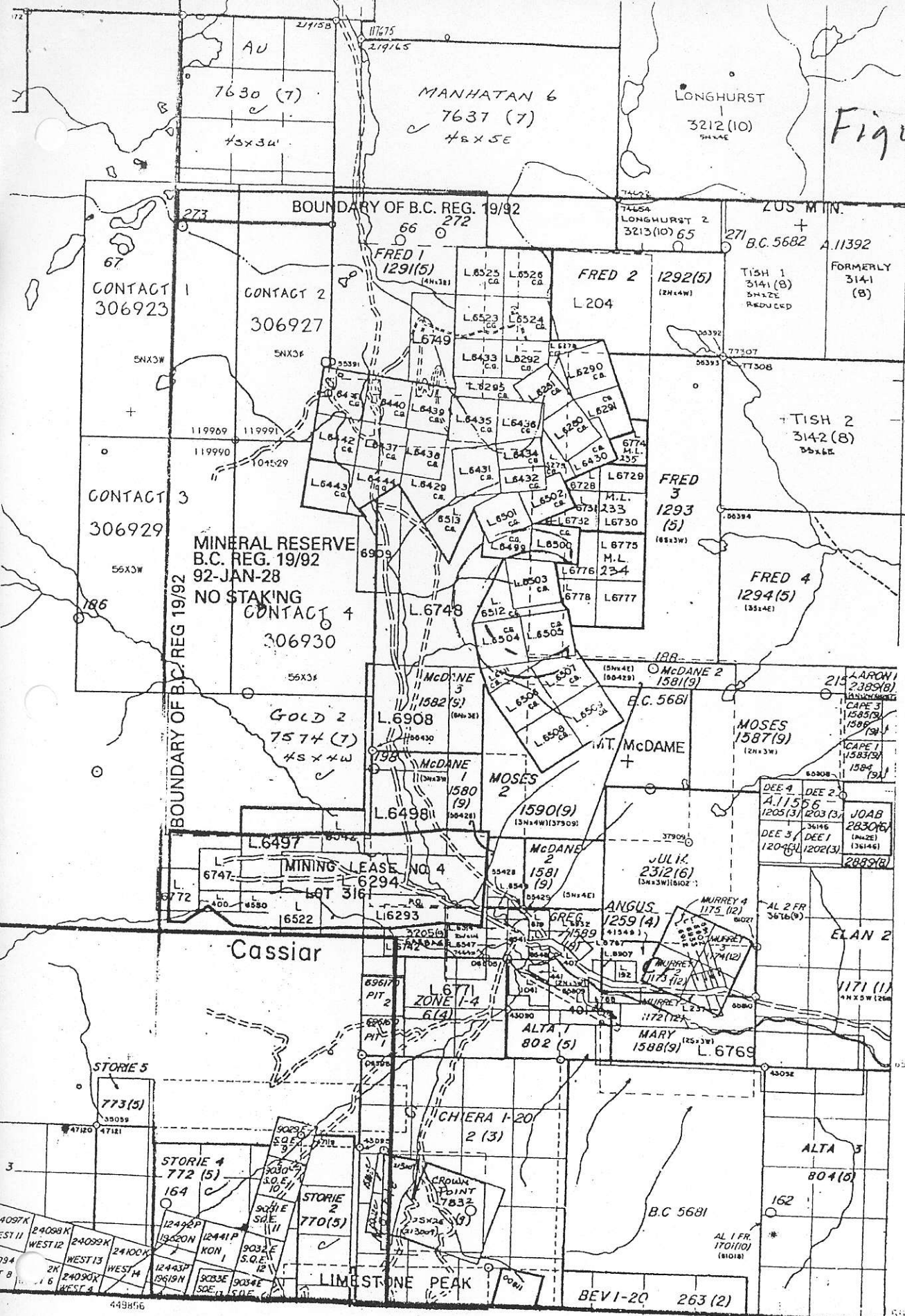


Figure 2



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
