- Tom George came into office @ 11:30 a.m. today & told me that his crews 'found' the CCP's for ELBOW 1 & 2 last week, and had established the claim lines.

- he said that the post he had found beside road & marked in early Nov. was 500 m. due North of the CCP's. Why would they put it 500 m. off road?? The ID (?) post had been previously been surveyed by me & found to be 300 m. E. of indicated <sup>map</sup> position.

Re: Elbow 1, Elbow 2 Mineral Claims, Cariboo M.D.

Please be advised that I wish to lodge a complaint under Section 50 of the B.C. Mineral Act concerning the above two claims. In support of this action, please find enclosed:

- a) Cheque for \$400 as the prescribed fee.
- b) Copies of the Double Registered letters sent to each of the recorded owners of the claims, and copies of the Post Office receipts.
- c) Copies of Form G for each of the above claims.

I am employed as a Geological Engineer by Mt. Calvery Resources Ltd. who have acquired eight nearby claims (C.G. 1-8) from several local prospectors. As well, I directed the staking of the SWAMP (4 x 5) claim, this latter claim filling a gap between Elbow 1, Elbow 2, and Jamboree 10, Jamboree 11 as plotted on the claim map. While trying to locate the boundaries of these adjacent claims, it became apparent to me that the legal corner posts had either been badly misplaced from their indicated locations, or more probably, had never in fact been staked on the ground. I conducted a thorough search of the area said to contain the two L.C.P.'s of the Elbow 1 and Elbow 2 on November 4, 1983 (3 hours) and again on November 8, 1983 (1 hour). As well, Mr. Jon George, a geologist employed by Tillicum Gold Mines of Vancouver, which company has apparently purchased the Elbow 1 and Elbow 2 claims, told me on the evening of November 5th, at Crooked Lake Lodge, that he and his assistant were unable to find any

indication of the claims, despite a 4 hour search that morning. In fact, there are no flagged or blazed lines in the area, nor any identification or corner posts.

Should your Department's investigation of this matter support the above complaint, I would wish to have the Record Number of each of the two claims (Elbow 1, Elbow 2) cancelled, and the ground held by the SWAMP claim, which overlaps the presumed location of the Elbow claims, be declared valid.
