KWUN CLAIMS

Summary

The Kwun claims are located 10 kilometres northeast of the town of Horsefly in the Cariboo Mining Division. Logging trails provide excellent access to most of the property.

The Kwun claims have been an active prospect for copper and gold since the early 1970's. Reassessment of the property since 1984 in light of the geology of the QR deposit has identified a coincident soil gold geochemical and induced polarization target. The target area is underlain by felsic breccais and conglomerates with interbedded basaltic rubble just south of a zoned alkalic stock.

<u>Claims</u>

The Kwun 1 to 4 claims consist of 48 units and are located in the Cariboo Mining Division on NIS mapsheet 93A/6W.
