The Issuer intends to carry out the work program recommended by George W.G. The work program consists of 5,000 feet of "fill-in" drilling to further define existing reserves and establish additional reserves in and around the Vera Main Zone as well as prospecting, mapping and soil sampling over other zones.

The exploration and development work carried out on the claims to date consists of geological mapping, soil geochemistry, rock geochemistry, biogeochemistry magnetometer surveys, induced polarization surveys, 40 drill holes (both diamond and percussion) and trenching.
