

MS Property

The MS property consists of 4 two-post claims staked by me on May 31, 1984. These claims are located on the headwaters of Fenell and Gollen creeks, at an elevation of $\approx 4500'$. Access is by road from Barriere, 23 miles.

As far as I know, the earliest work done on this property was undertaken by Dynasty Exploration Limited in 1971. This work consisted of geological mapping, soil sampling and a magnetometer survey. In 1975 J.A. Fennel drilled two X-Ray holes totaling 76.5 meters.

The MS claims are underlain by a chlorite schist-greenstone unit in contact with a limestone unit. Seven copper showings are found in the chlorite schist along a strike length of 2500'. These copper showings are located within an envelope of silicification, pyritization and potassium feldspar alteration. (A.R. 3430). This alteration is confined to the chlorite schist-greenstone unit.

While the sampling of these showings, by Dynasty, averaged only 0.43% Au, it is interesting to note that there is record of any samples run for gold. It is also interesting to note that there has never been an E.M. survey done to test for massive sulfide conductors.
