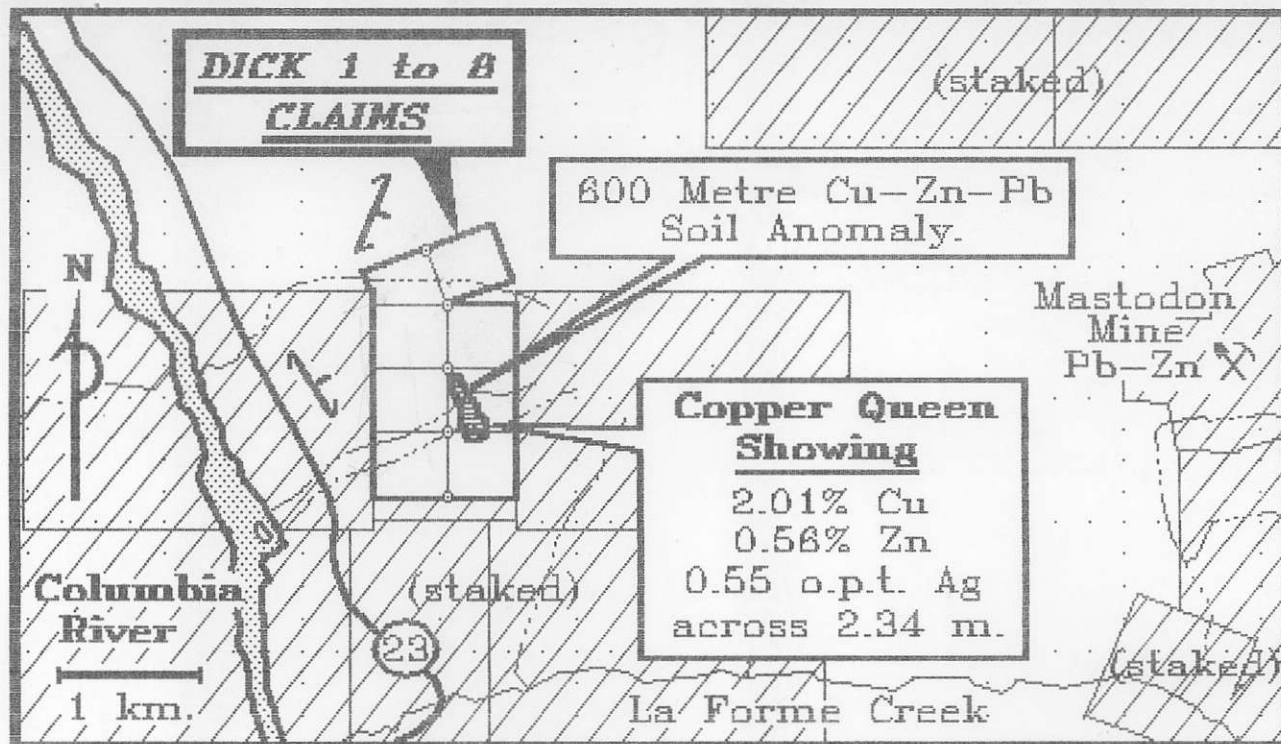

Revelstoke, British Columbia

Location

The Dick claim group is located 31 kilometres north of Revelstoke B.C., one kilometre east of the Columbia River.

Claim Status

The Dick claim group consists of 8 two post claims as follows:  
Dick 1 to 8      601217M to -224M      Expire: June 15, 1990

Mineralization

The Dick claims cover the Copper Queen Cu-Zn-Pb prospect. The Copper Queen occurs within north westerly trending, east dipping Lower Cambrian metamorphic rocks of the Lardeau Group. The Lardeau Group is host to numerous Cu-Zn-Pb-Ag-Au deposits including the J & L (6 km. north east), and Goldstream (51 km. north west). On the Dick claims, chalcopyrite, sphalerite, pyrite and malachite occur in limy meta-volcanic chlorite schists near the contact with overlying quartz sericite schists. The zone of mineralization is conformable with schistosity and up to 6 metres thick.

Previous Work

1968: Coldwater Mines Ltd.

Three holes drilled; intersection of 6.1 metres of 0.85% Cu reported.

1976: Kerr Addison Mines Limited.

Extensive soil and stream geochemical sampling program outlining 600 by 150 metre Cu-Zn-Pb anomaly. Drilling recommended but never followed up. Sampling returned 2.34 metres of 2.01% Cu, 0.56% Zn and 0.55 o.p.t. Ag.

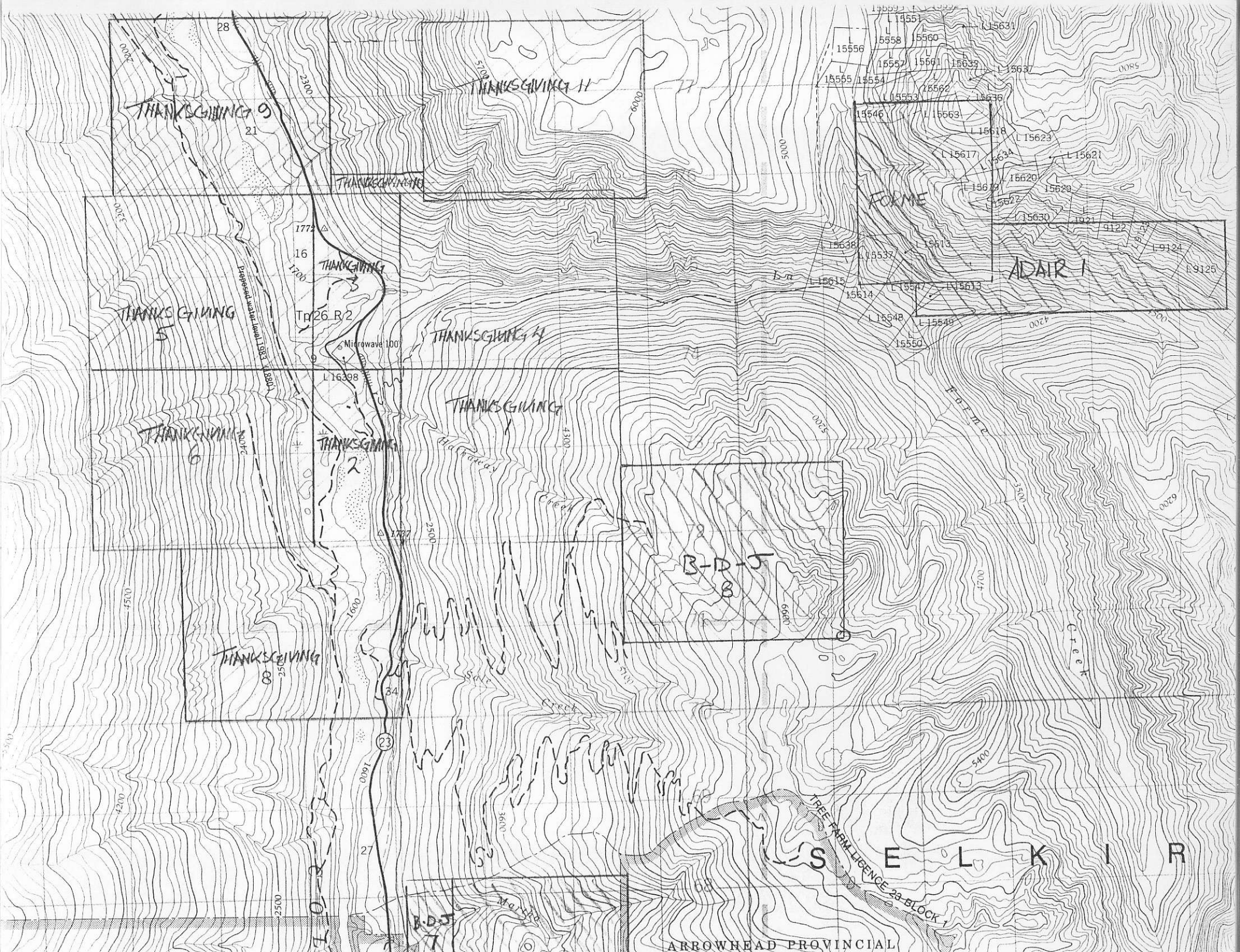

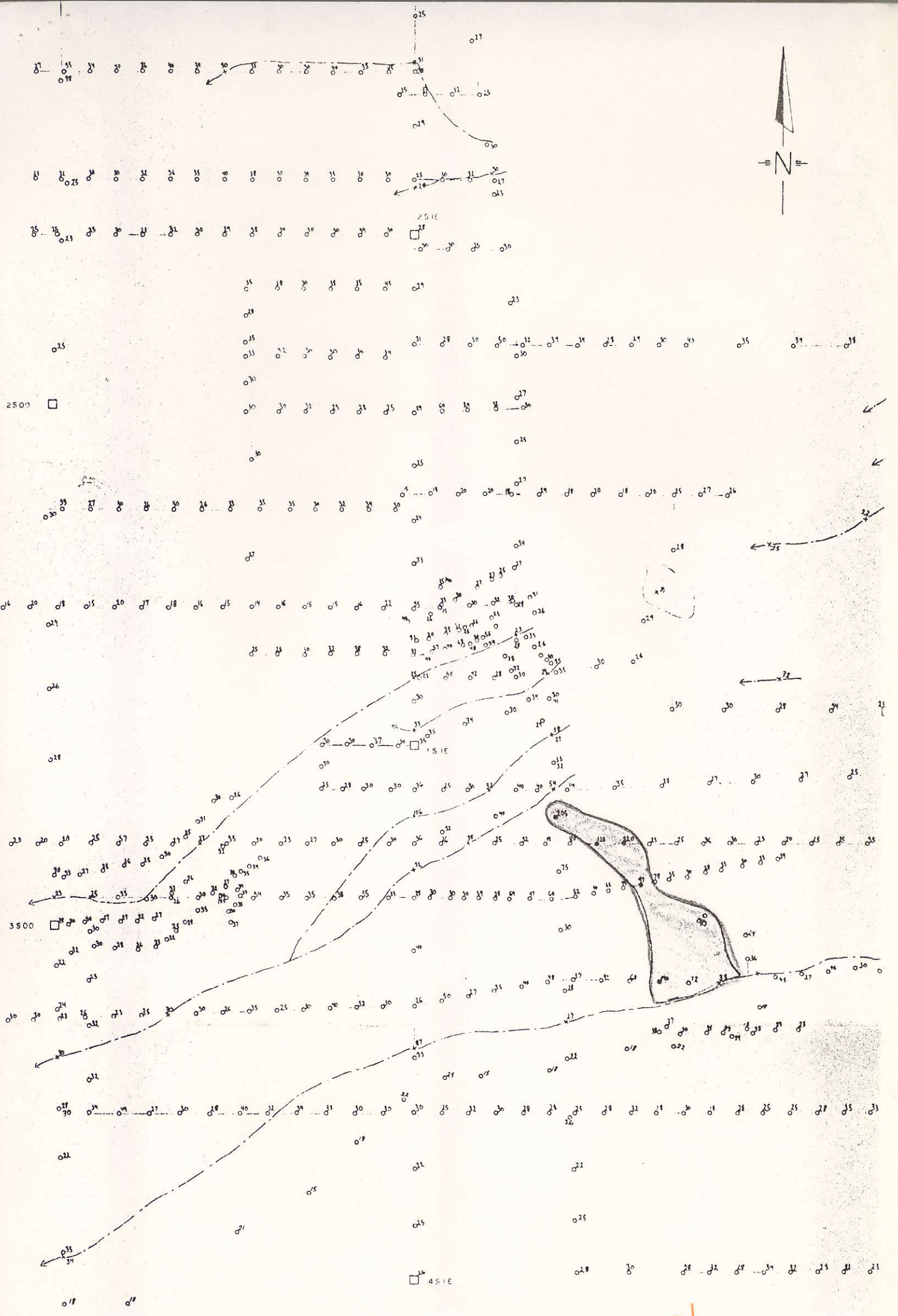
