Dear Mr. Lumsden

Work is progressing on the claim staking however the ground is very difficult to work hence the pace is slower than expected. The old mill site is covered by Adam Thompson's claims however, the mill itself is worthless except perhaps for firewood.

Adam and I have been attempting to find the old claim lines to extend the 5 or 6 groups of claims however w/ weather and heavy underbrush make the task of finding old location lines impossible hence we will likely run new lines. I am altering the staking pattern slightly & adding 2 claims along the probable extension of the shear zone. Many of the minor cross cutting shears are mineralised but apparently only with pyrite, hematite or goethite. Sikes cross cut through the property but again appear barren.

Detailed mapping of the shear zone will be difficult - most of the ground is hard to reach. I could use a good climbing rope & more harness, which I shall try to arrange for. I will need some for some of the terrain as I do not trust sampling float in this region & would prefer to sample the faces directly. Most outcrop is vertical rounded granite bluffs, which can be reached by going down from the top by rope, or up using pitons.
