

On the Ben property, 10 km east of the Gibraltar copper mine, soil sampling indicated several areas anomalous in arsenic and antimony. In one creek section silicified Cache Creek Group sediments contain anomalous gold (100 ppb), arsenic, antimony and nickel. An intensively silicified and quartz veined zone a short distance to the east is enriched in antimony. The significance of the alteration and anomalies has not yet been determined and further work is required.

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
