holes on The Soup (100 feet total). 11 holes totalling 3,239 feet on the  
KLI. Drill indicated reserves on the KLI 0.5 to 1 million tons grading  
905 oz/ton Au, 0.46% Cu and 0.20 oz/ton Ag.

CAPSULIZED GEOLOGY: Underlain by Takla Group andesitic volcanics and volcanoclastic  
sedimentary rocks. Gold and copper occur in gossanous areas of silicification and pyritization  
within the andesites.
