re: REB MINERAL CLAIMS

Enclosed herewith are maps and notes pertaining to the location of the REB 1-4 mineral claims and the staking of REB 5-8.

My comments follow:

1. Percy Cox relocated the L.C.P. for REB 1-4 and confirms their location as originally noted.
2. Some question still exists as to the location of the massive pyrite showing if one is to relate it to the location of the Esso fly camp. Cox thinks the fly camp is 3 creeks further to the west, therefore, the pyrite may also be on that creek to the west thus putting it on REB 7 and not REB 6.

As there still appears to be some question as to where the showing really is, I suggest that work be filed on REB 1 and 2 which looks after covering possible westward extensions of the zone. As work was done off the REB 1 and 2 and during a period prior to the staking of REB 5-8, is there not a provision in the Act that allows work off claims but related to the claims to be allowed for assessment work credit?

Alternatively, if Cox is correct in his location of the fly camp, perhaps this places the area of concentration of your work sufficiently close enough to the REB 1 and 2 so that a portion of the work may indeed lie on the claims.

As a third alternative we may have sufficient funds in our PAC account to aid in the filing of assessment work.

We would agree to letting REB 3 and 4 lapse, work carried out in 1981 would be applied to REB 5-8.

Attached please find copies of the REB 5-8 (35 units) staked near Pesika and Ospika Creeks in the Omineca Mining Division.

Also enclosed please find staker's location sketches and Mining Receipt No. 154013E and the aerial photo you kindly lent to us.

You will note on the mylar overlay you kindly forwarded to us, that the Fly Camp as noted in ink on mylar was discovered to be located in error, our field crews during new staking in fact found the Fly Camp was over 1 kilometer West of where Esso's field people plotted it to be. (See our location mylar film noted in pencil.) During this new staking of REB 5-8 Percy Cox revisited the location of REB 1-4 and found them to be exactly as noted in the exact location as noted on our stakers sketch as presented to MRO on recording of REB 1-4.
