1966 - P. 118:

July - October 2 machines drilled 4000'. ODIN Group.

Area described as to the East of Carleton, i. This sounds like the Emma &amp; Lime Kiln Springs.

1967 - P. 243:

ODIN &amp; VAN Groups, E 120 chimo granted to 7500'.

12 man for 6 mi. E 50 & 60 + 6 D.D.H. E 3, 271'

+ 6 mi. roads.

This drilling may be in the down-dip tests on the Van(?) Spring.

J.R. contacted Doug Malcolm re. the location of these 1966-1967 D.D. Holes by Northwest Zinc. Malcolm could not give any information on location of hole as he said that Carruthers kept all the data to himself. Efforts by Malcolm, Fowler & Casick to get these data from Carruthers were to no avail.

J.R. located 2 deep holes which tested down-dip extension south of Empress Lake area.
