CAMP BRAVOPROSPECT AREA: RUTH LAKE

104 N/2W, 3E, 5E, 6W.

LAT: 59°15' N LONG: 133°00' W.

SERPENTINITE + TALC BEARING ULTRAMAFIC ROCKS INTRUDE SEDIMENTS AND GREENSTONES OF THE CACHE CREEK SEQUENCE. DARYL BRUNS INDICATED THE EAST CIRQUE AS THE LOCATION OF OLD WORKINGS SEARCHED FOR SOME YEARS AGO BY AN OLD TIMER WHO IS NOW DEAD. A STRONG RUST ZONE IS APPARENT BUT NOTHING TO INDICATE WORKINGS WAS SEEN FROM THE AIR. THE GENERAL SEQUENCE OF ROCK IS SIMILAR TO THE ATLIN PLACER AREA.

THE PINK GRANITE AREA SHOULD BE LOOKED AT, PARTICULARLY ALONG THE NORTH CONTACT, FOR QUARTZ VEINS ETC.

THE REGIONAL GEOCHEM DOES NOT SHOW ANY ANOMALOUS VALUES BUT THE RUSTY CREEK ENTERING THE POND WAS NOT SAMPLED.

YOU MAY HAVE TO CAMP IN THE VALLEY (SOUTHWEST?) OF THE EAST CIRQUE TO FIND TREES TO SET UP CAMP.
