The stuff I knew about had a few piddling trenches on it and was within a few miles of the hot springs. No doubt its now covered by the seven or eight hundred claims they staked under Dick Woodcocks' direction.

Regards the silver prospect on Cherry Creek and of which you have a copy of the report by P.E. Peterson. Should you find anyone interested a very cheap deal could be arranged. We are now in possession of the title forms and this ground is convenient enough that some shallow drilling could be done at any time of the year. The showing will probably turn out to be a pretty erratic occurrence but there are also some high values to consider. We would go along with someone who would put up the money to do about five hundred feet of diamond-drilling in say five one hundred foot holes. Another alternative would be to pump out the shaft and try and resample but this may involve finding everything to be caved in or filled up at the bottom. We would contract this work ~~on the basis of no cash involved~~ on the basis of no cash involved for the property pending results of the work and even then a prior agreement could be arranged on a stock basis in lieu of cash. If they gamble the money for the work we'll gamble the property right now.
