Enclosed is some maps and field notes for the Church Lake area. The stuff was in my briefcase which I didn't clean out until just recently - sorry about that.

The volcanic conglomerate is a quite extensive unit. The Wit-Wag showing is a good syngenetic type mineralization with a good chemical sediment zone that is at least 20 m. ~~thick~~ thick, good sphalerite + galena. Some tuff-breccia occurs in the area. In the one assessment report, it was stated that Noranda had hit a pod (20,000 T.?) of Pb-Zn, so the area does have massive sulfide potential. If you have the budget next year, I would recommend more work for the area, gotta be a massive sulfide deposit there somewhere.
