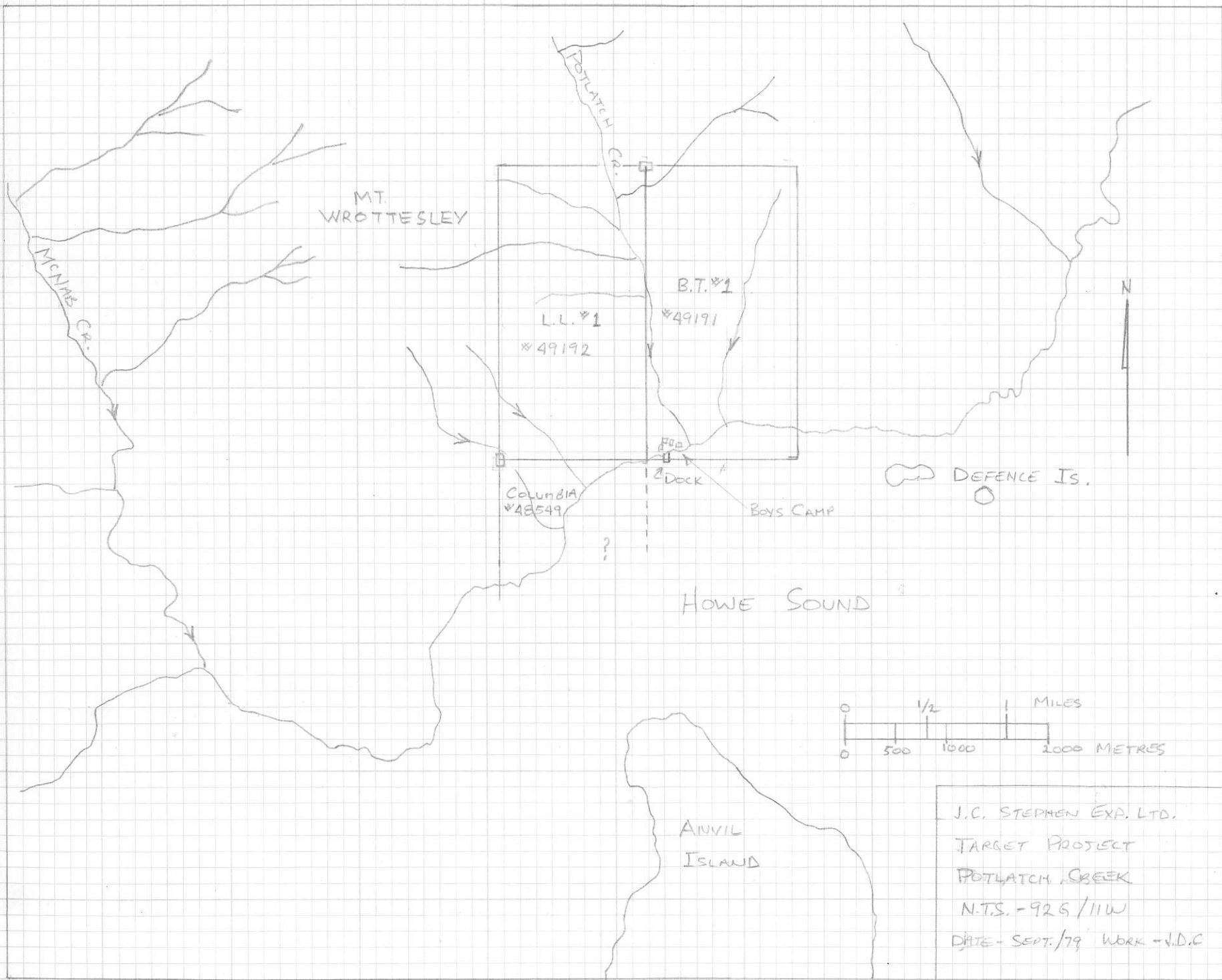

ON SEPTEMBER 8, 1979 THE LOCATION AND ACCESS TO A MOLYBDENUM ANOMALY ON POTLATCH CREEK WAS INVESTIGATED. IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT ACCESS BY RENTAL BOAT FROM HORSESHOE BAY WOULD BE IMPRACTICAL AS THE DISTANCE IS TOO GREAT AND THEREFORE TIME CONSUMING. A WATER TAXI SERVICE FROM HORSESHOE BAY WOULD BE RELIABLE IF BOOKED WELL IN ADVANCE. IT WAS DECIDED TO USE A 12 FOOT BOAT AND 5 HORSE POWER MOTOR ON LOAN FROM J.C. STEPHEN EXPLORATIONS LTD. SAID BOAT AND MOTOR PROVED TO BE ADEQUATE, WEATHER PERMITTING.

ON SEPTEMBER 9, 1979 THE BOAT WAS LAUNCHED AT PORTSAU, CROSSING TO POTLATCH CREEK IN 25 MINUTES. SUCH A CROSSING IN A SMALL BOAT WOULD BE QUESTIONABLE IN MODERATE TO HEAVY WEATHER. IT WAS DISCOVERED THAT THREE CLAIM GROUPS HAD BEEN STAKED COVERING THE AREA OF INTEREST.
