CLAIMS Staked April 1986

ACCESS Highway north from Nanaimo to Rosewall Cr Road north of Bowser thence  
westerly to Horn Lake Road

METALS Reported Sb, Cu with Hg As possible Ag Au.

SAMPLE RESULTS Placer had sampled - ICP indicated Hg Cu Zn very little Au.  
Bilquist had taken 5 or 6 silts from main creek and series of soil samples  
along upper road. Did not have results as yet.

GEOLOGY Area is mapped as Karmutsen volcanics and that is supported by all outcrop  
and float seen. Volcanics are generally massive, dark green, with some  
jointing and/or flow structures. Pillow structures are reported at top  
road - not visited. Feldspar porphyry dykes reported and a strongly altered  
dyke occurs at main "showing".

ALTERATION Buff brown ankeritic alteration occurs in weak to strong, narrow to wide  
zones on the main road approaching the property, as showings on the logging  
road in the property, and as float in the creek. Largest zone on upper  
property road outcrops in road cut for 200 feet (?).

MINERALIZATION Minor pyrite and rare cpy were seen in float and in outcrop. Stibnite  
occurs (Bilquist hand samples) but no strong mineralization or apparent  
mineralized structure was seen.

OPINION May be interesting prospecting and may give geochem anomalies but no  
mineralized prospect is evident as yet.
