RE: FLAGGING OF GEOCHEMICAL ANOMALY AND ASSESSMENT OF ACCESS POSSIBILITIES
ON THE SNOW PROPERTY. ALBERNI MINING DIVISION.

On July 26 and 27 I went to the SNOW property to flag out the outline of our geochemistry anomalies and to look for a possible trail down to the anomaly with an excavator. The bulk of the anomaly extends down the hill in the green timber, and is quite steep. Good access could be established from a lower bench but sharp bluffs block the way from the clearcut area to the main anomaly area. If desperate it may be possible to build a cat track from the most western part of the clear cut down to the bench but it is quite steep and may require some rock blasting. At the moment however, there has been no log removal at all from the clear cut and will not be any till at best early September. As a result we will not be able to start a cat track until then.

MacMillan Bloedel has a logging road planned to go into the anomaly area from the east. If a strong push is put onto this road building it may be possible that there will be access by October 1989.
