RE: Ap, Rain, Robin, Claims 92F/6W Alberni

On February 6 and 7 I accompanied J.C. Stephen and Bob and Doug Paterson on a property exam of the Rain, Ap, and Robin Claims west of Great Central Lake, in the Alberni mining district, (NTS 92F/6W).

Mineralization on the claims is dominated by Py and traces of Cpy+/-Mo, associated with quartz veining or stockworking within Volcanic or granodioritic host rocks.

A total of 18 samples were collected from these claims and were analysed by a 30 element ICP and gold geochem (Chemex Labs). Unfortunately the best gold value obtained was 110 ppb from a sample of massive sulphides from Ap#4. It would appear that the mineralizing quartz veins and sulphides was not a gold rich system.

Based on the results of the samples taken, the Ap, Rain, and Robin claims could not be recommended as precious metal prospects.
