Size:	The Jim MacDonald Will claim of 16 units surrounds the 8 two post Troy claims held by Integrated Resources Ltd. The main part of the mineralized zone is on the two post claims.	
Access:	Road access by way of the Stewart Cassiar highway passes about 2 km west of the mineralized zone. A 4 wheel drive road provides local access. The property is 20 miles south of Dease Lake.	•
