UNIT 1:

- a Rhyolite: generally blue-grey in colour with bright, yellow-red weathering and strongly fractured; varieties also include a clear to white feldspar (?) porphyry and kaolinized phase.
- b Chert brecciated rhyolite. - Abundant diss. pyrite.
- c Agglomerate - fragments include rhyolite (all varieties), quartz, chert, and very fine black mudstone. Groundmass is generally quite silicious and contains abundant, blebby pyrite. Shows graded bedding in places.
- Quartz veining: varies from massive to drusy; white to black. No visible mineralization.
- Channel sample number, location and size.
