Air photos and overlays are enclosed for Terror Creek. Sorry but we didn't have time to do the 3 boundary posts. It shouldn't be a problem that they're missing. If you would like them in maybe they could be dropped when a chopper goes to Alpha. The locations are well marked by orange flagging and are all in a row on top in the open. Locations and info are on one of air photo overlays.

We flew into the area NW of Mt Okeefe ^(geo map) as marked on air photo overlays sent to us. However, ~~the~~ Mt Okeefe is marked in two different places on geo + topo maps. Therefore, since we haven't found anything significant here we are wondering whether we should be relative

to the other Mt Okeefe (located south of G.B. Ck!)
as shown on topo map. We have found old
camps and picket lines on this hill ^(NW Mt Ok - geo map) but no
Asb or Cu and have checked out ^{v. rusty}
ultramafic zone \approx 2 miles W. of Mt OK
(geo map). The intrusion (15b) was investigated
and a small uninteresting trench in
unmineralized diorite (15c?) was found 1-2 miles
NW of Mt OK. (topo map) as well as rock
cave with many tags, dating to 1967. The area
W. of Mt OK (topo) was also checked out
past the fault + to the Laberge sed. Therefore
our move on Sun is to Mt OK (topo) in
hope that Daryl can point out some of the
showings and possibly the "2' wide chalcocite vein" (?)

By the way, the shovel is to replace the one Glen
lost at Hirschfield Ck. last summer. ^{That's it for now, have}
