- ① These claims are due for assessment work not later than August 23 1979.
- ② Berne Industries have drilled holes for geochem samples and have sent the samples to Chemex. They should be finished by July 30. They should send us (1) a bill
(2) descriptions of samples + numbers.
(3) the maps we sent them showing which holes were drilled.
- ③ The claims will have to be grouped depending on how much work was done and where. One group will have 40 units and require \$4000 assessment work. The other will have 37 units and require \$3700 assess work. See bottom of B/W air photo print for two way to group.
NEED FORMS FOR GROUPING.
- ④ The total cost of BEMA should be distributed to each group in proportion to the amount of work done on that group. Total of BEMA was not to exceed \$6,000 including Chemex geochem - see letter to BEMA.
- ⑤ The cost of geochem - BEMA + CHEMEX for each group is to be entered on the front and back of the "Statement of Expenditures" for each group - 2 copies to Dept Mines, 1 for Dome, 1 for JCS. These should be in the order of \$2846 on the group with 37 units and \$3076 on the group with 40 units. At the bottom, back side, of Statement of Expenditures use ~~7600~~

Keep w/ reports

$\$1000$ from PAC account for the 37 unit group and 1000 from PAC acct for the 40 unit group to make up to $\$3700$ and $\$4000$ respectively. This requires a bill of ~~$\$5400$~~ ^{$\6000} from BEMA. If their bill is more - then loss will be needed out of PAC. If their bill is less put in $\$300$ ^{400} for me as time spent on supervision + report

- ⑥ Forms to reduce size of claim groups, Statements of Expenditure and a cheque for $\$5$ per $\$100$ assessment work + $\$5 \times 2$ for grouping are to be filed with the Mining Recorder in Vancouver before Aug 23.
