DRUM PROPERTY

The location of the > 250 ppm Mo geochem in outcrop on the new logging road was visited briefly by JCS on May 24. Alternating altered volcanics and porphyritic intrusive with some fine grained acid dyke material was seen. Hematite staining is common, contacts are relatively steep, rock is well fractured.

No significant mineralization was observed although sample flags 80833 and 80834 were found

The intrusive is coarse grained pink quartz monz with large pink feldspar phenos. It may be part of the Cg porph intrusive occurring sporadically in an arc around the productive inner younger phases of the Topley intrusives as described by Ed Kimura (May 19 visit) No further work is suggested
