Re: Okanagan Falls Property

Dear Jack:

I am enclosing, herewith, some of the information that we have on the referenced property.

Ajax has an agreement with the owners of this 33 claim property on Mount Christie. At this stage little has been said about the acquisition, as Ajax is endeavouring to stake the surrounding areas which are open, in order to cover the entire "plug" and the outer edges as shown on the geological map enclosed.

The property is accessible by road from Okanagan Falls; and parts of the Lynx #1 to 4 have cat trails and trenches cut in 1966 by General Resources. Some mineral was uncovered in this program and is plotted on the map produced by Beaton in October 1966.

In 1968 Gunnex Limited did a small program on the property; just enough to cover assessment, and Ken Rose wrote the enclosed report and produced a geochem map, and a magnetic map, copies of which are enclosed. Apparently, these surveys produced nothing exciting. On discussion with Rose, he was favourably impressed anyway, particularly with the geological setting, the presence of copper, silver mineralization and because it has not been gone over, apparently, prior to 1966. My discussions with him indicated Gunnex failed to pursue further at Toronto's direction; the program they did was not extensive enough, as they had not done basic prospecting at all and had made no effort to extend the showings.

This report indicates that a 33 foot width was in view which ran a channel @ .75 copper and .6 oz. silver. Samples from the property that I have were assayed and a spectro run, copies of which are included.

Please give this your consideration, as we would like to have a recommendation of where to start in a modest program. We can arrange for a program of prospecting, some stripping and some drilling, if warranted, on whatever you suggest as a starter.
