

Freddie Camp - N. Silins, A. Candy  
August 19-20, 1982

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Camp was established on the Creek draining Taku Mtn to the north; located near camp the claim post on the NW of the Ear Claims was found.

Two traverses were made on the 19 and 20 - one to the west of the cirque and ~~one~~ one to the east. A rock sample of the ~~the~~ "rusty" outcrop was obtained the first day - the rock was found to be a Andesite(?) Breccia (#32861 d). A chip sample ~~flag~~ was found near quartz vined Andesite - consequently sample #32862 d was taken.

The dominant rock type in the area is the Andesite(?) and Andesite Breccia. Some of the Breccia also shows Qtz & Jasper (Red) in filling. ~~#~~ On the <sup>east</sup> ~~west~~ side of the valley the rocks approximately correlated to the Andesites of the west although no contact was found on either side. Rock sample 32863 d was taken on the east side covering a quartz vien.

Three talus samples as well as a soil sample was taken to provide

geochemical data. A silt sample was taken at the camp stream.

The camp was found to be most adequate and the weather was clear + sunny.
