Dear Bruce;

Enclosed are lists of samples to be run for uranium and for gold.

After our perusal of the GSC open file on uranium in south east B.C. I feel we should make it our practice to run uranium geochem on the <100 mesh fraction of the samples. This will require extra preparation time in your lab but should sharpen up the anomalies. Whether the method is as applicable in central B.C. as it appears to be in southeastern B.C. will be seen after we have more experience. These samples are from widely scattered areas and varied geology.

If for any reason you feel this extra preparation is impractical or unnecessary I would appreciate your opinion.

The 43 samples for Au analysis have already been run for several elements and may be short of material but we would appreciate whatever you are able to do with them. They are samples generally anomalous for Zn, As and in some cases Cu and Mo in the Quesnel River area and follow regional trends generally. There is at least one small gold prospect in the area.
