Summary

The Au Sb claims lie in the
same belt of rocks hosting
several small Au-Ag-Sb-As vein
showings. Interest in these showings
has been renewed due to the
promotional play by Levon and Keron
on their claims in the area.
Very little new work has been
carried out except for re-sampling
the old ~~of~~ vein showings.
Apparently no work has
been carried out on the Au Sb claims.

The area was ^{likely} very thoroughly prospected by the old-timers and the absence of crown grants on the claims suggests that this earlier work failed to uncover any well-mineralized continuous vein mineralization.

Although it is possible that some of the vein showings might be ~~economically~~ able to support ~~developed economically by~~ a ~~small~~

small high-grading operation, it is unlikely that ~~any~~ ~~any significant~~ ~~tonnage~~ sufficient tonnage could be outlined to justify a full-scale mining operation.

The lack of known showings and

the limited potential of this
deposit type indicates that ~~the~~ the
Aus6 claims have little value other
than their promotional position.
