Dear Mr. Sargent:

I append a rough sketch of the northerly cut on the old copper prospect on Quadra Island on the Seymour Narrows side, where Dr. Gunning got his sample containing vanadium, and where Dr. Walker checked it.

If Mr. Crowe-Swords has a copy of Professor Sayers' map of Radium Explorers Incorporated, this cut is shown in the southerly corner of the Violet D claim, and 600 feet west of a station called Mackenzie Tree. Dr. Walker also took a sample from black siliceous material in the southerly cut of the old copper workings but without results.

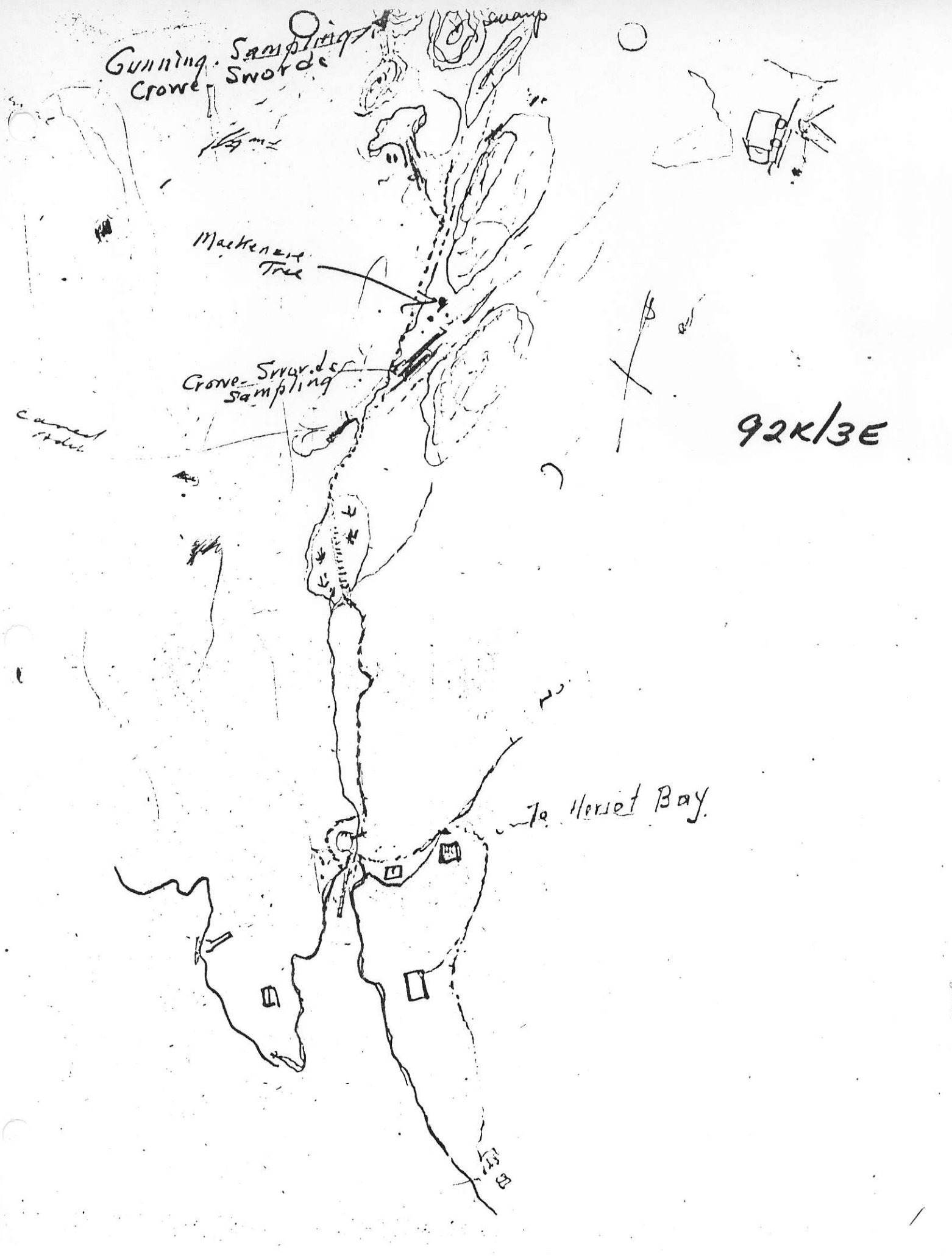
