THAN DRILLING.

The background in this area is not less than 80 counts per minute. Further complications arise when the scintolometer is moved laterally along the box because the background varies. I am now doing the radiometric work on later dock using 5' to 6' of water as radioactive shield which helps somewhat. Presently I am logging the holes from 69-7 back and the core in reverse order as well to find area not radioactive significantly. The red arkose does not extend beyond 80' in this hole number 69-7. No red arkose in 69-8 to 22'. Holes 69-5 and 69-6 have radiometric kicks in top but these ratings so far have been so unsatisfactory due to size background not lateral change that I have disregarded and plan to re-do them. During reading the weather must be relatively good or I cannot work well since I am in the open and the weather definitely not good. May I suggest one hole north of 1A. Send in coordinates if another hole to be done. They have virtually completed all the holes laid out and he mentioned that 1100' would be finished by today. They were just finishing No. 69-9.
