Dear George:

Mr. Bronlund asked me by telephone what work had been done at Takla Silver since Campbell's report came out. Prior to his report coming out he advised me of the program he recommended. The part I carried out was further drilling on the zinc, No. 4 zone, and driving approx. 60' of tunnel north from the end of the cross cut on the No. 1 zone. This vein was intersected 270' below the surface cut, and a little to the west of vertical. This indicates that the No. 1 drill hole, drilled by Bralorne, and possible No. 2, never reached this far west. For this reason Campbell thinks we should drill from underground, cutting this vein under the surface ore shoot approx. 250' long, going south from the corss cut. We should also set up in the face of this last drift and drill east, cutting the zones through drill holes 1 & 2, and towards 3 & 4 drilled by Bralorne. This is what Campbell advises, and to me it makes sense, and I hope your people will see it this way, as then we will be unanimous for better or worse.

In Campbell's opinion it is quite possible to indicate by drilling from the tunnel, 200,000 tons of 25 oz. silver ore in this vicinity. This would justify a 200 ton plant, with the veins open north, south and down.

I should also say that Campbell does not agree with outlining further low grade zinc ore until the transportation would make this an economical ore body. We now have indicated one million tons of approx. \$20.00 ore. There is no doubt this could be multiplied many times over when transportation makes it feasible to mine this at a profit.

I told Emil over the phone where the camp equipment is stored, and he knows who to contact.
