The samples that you received were taken from surface trenches at the Takla Silver property north of Fort St. James, B.C., at 55°30' North Latitude and 125°30' East Longitude, in the Manson Creek area. These surface trenches were cut at approximately 50' intervals across a 250' strike length of a vein-like structure.
