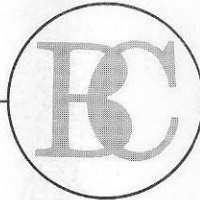

MEMORANDUM

on the

CORKY GROUP

The writer has reviewed the February 29th, 1972 report of Dr. H.A. Quin on the Corky Group, Kamloops Mining Division, B.C.

Herewith are the essential facts concerning the Corky group:

1. The property is 3 miles north of Lac Le Jeune. It is accessible by road from Kamloops.
2. The property is on the western margin of the Nicola batholith. Although largely covered by overburden, it is reasonable to assume that bedrock consists of the Nicola Group of volcanic rocks that outcrop over a large part of south central B.C.
3. The Nicola rocks are favourable rocks for copper mineralization. These rocks host the Cragmont and Similkameen copper deposits.
4. Ten miles to the north, the Afton copper prospect appears definitely to have the makings of another substantial copper mine.
5. Aeromagnetic anomalies over the Corky group could have economic significance. They warrant exploration.
6. The \$20,000 first stage program recommended by Dr. Quin is a modest program with which the writer is in accord. Stages 2 and 3 are conditional on the success of the preceding stage.
