The enclosed information concerning our CHEK claim group shows the result of our fairly detailed silt sampling which followed up on reconnaissance work in 1972. We are open to discussion of an option if you should be interested.

We were originally looking for porphyry type deposits and because of very sparse outcrop, this cannot be entirely ruled out. However, the combination of copper-zinc-lead-silver values and lack of extensive pyrite, rock alteration or float suggests to me the cause is due to vein type zones, perhaps similar to the Topley-Richfield to the west.

Access to the property is relatively easy for tractor or skidder-type vehicles by way of the Topley-Richfield road. George Watson, who was with Terry Janes on the property, saw tracks made by hunters with what was probably a Jeep.

James felt further soil sampling fruitless because of the nature of the soil.
