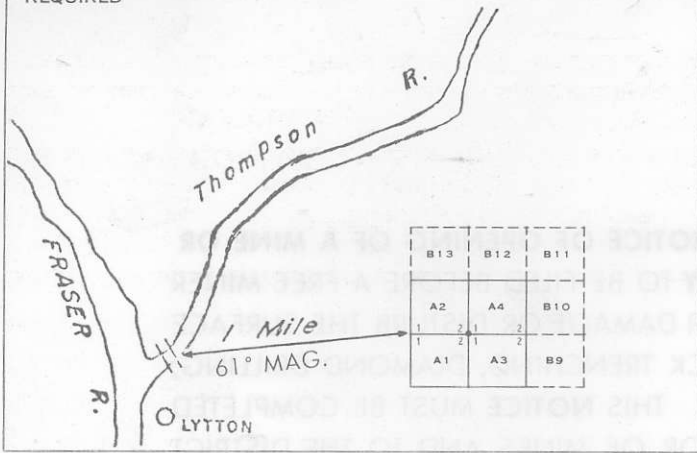

EXAMPLE OF TYPE OF SKETCH REQUIRED



CLAIMS MUST BE TIED BY DIRECTION AND DISTANCE TO AT LEAST ONE, PREFERABLY MORE THAN ONE, TOPOGRAPHICAL FEATURE, SUCH AS THE JUNCTIONS OF CREEKS AND RIVERS, OR TO A LAND LOT, SECTION, TOWNSHIP, OR OTHER RECOGNIZABLE POINT ON PRINTED MAPS OF THE DISTRICT. RELATIONSHIP OF PREVIOUSLY LOCATED CLAIMS SHOULD ALSO BE SHOWN.

N. B. - THE SKETCH FOR A GROUP OF CLAIMS MAY BE PLACED ON ONE AFFIDAVIT.

FREE MINERS RESPONSIBILITIES

NOTICE OF OPENING

THE MINES REGULATION ACT REQUIRES **NOTICE OF OPENING OF A MINE OR QUARRY, OR OF WORK ON A MINERAL PROPERTY** TO BE FILED BEFORE A FREE MINER ENGAGES IN WORK WHICH WILL CAUSE TIMBER DAMAGE OR DISTURB THE SURFACE IN A MATERIAL WAY (e.g. LINE CUTTING, ROCK TRENCHING, DIAMOND DRILLING, BULLDOZING) ON OR TO A MINERAL CLAIM. THIS **NOTICE** MUST BE COMPLETED AND FORWARDED TO THE DISTRICT INSPECTOR OF MINES AND TO THE DISTRICT FOREST RANGER.

IN ADDITION TO THE ORIGINAL NOTIFICATION BOTH THE INSPECTOR AND RANGER SHOULD BE NOTIFIED EVERY TIME WORK STARTS AFTER ANY SHUTDOWN.

SURFACE

FREE MINERS WHO ENTER LANDS ALREADY LAWFULLY OCCUPIED FOR OTHER THAN MINING PURPOSES MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE OWNER OF THE LANDS TO POST SECURITY FOR ANY LOSS OR DAMAGE WHICH MAY BE CAUSED BY THE ENTRY.

SHOULD LOSS OR DAMAGE ARISE AS A RESULT OF ENTRY, THE FREE MINER MUST BY LAW MAKE FULL COMPENSATION TO THE OCCUPANT OR OWNER.

FREE MINERS, WHO ENTER ON PRIVATE LAND FOR THE PURPOSES OF MINING EXPLORATION AND DEVELOPMENT, SHOULD IN THE INTEREST OF HARMONY, CONTACT THE OCCUPANT AND OWNER PRIOR TO COMMENCING WORK. FREE MINERS WHO DESCRIBE THE NATURE AND EXTENT OF WORK PLANNED ON THEIR MINERAL PROPERTIES, WILL FIND THAT CONFLICTS OF USE WITH LAND OWNERS CAN OFTEN BE RESOLVED AMICABLY.
