Since the anniversary date for the first 8 claims is June 27, I suppose the assessment report should be <sup>ready</sup> pretty soon. What are the exact terms for when it should be filed and what does the 30 day extension mean?

For figuring out the amount of money that can be put towards assessment, I must know each persons salary per day. Along these lines, can only work days be charged up - what about sitting up camp, helicopter time, food etc. I imagine the "type" report you will send in may point all this out.

Also, what's the score for fractional claims? There is a chance we have a very thin shiver here, because <sup>the</sup> drainage on the west side of the claims between the bottom 2 lines is 3000 ft. It appears the magnetic high from the hill may have thrown off the compasses as all the cut lines also bend. More detailed tracing in will determine if there is a portion - I can't remember exactly what you write on the claim post about what borders the fractional claim.

Line cutting is proceeding well. They hope to be finished by Friday afternoon. Total line miles to cut is just short of 8 miles.

The mag survey is proceeding okay. The only interesting thing so far is that the magnetic differences between the hill and the flat surrounding country is not that great. Magnetic change considerably from day to day but after corrections, readings seem consistent.

I am quite optimistic about this property right now and if we get any good I. P. results in the right places I would be almost ecstatic. I'm hoping to find that there have been other rather <sup>the</sup> intrusions than the porphyry, localized by considerable faulting. Geochron results coincide with intersections of NE - NW air photo linears. Fracturing and mineralization at the southern end of the porphyry may be related to emplacement of another (mineralized?) porphyry.
