DIX Claims

Dear Cam,

I've finished mapping the DIX Claims in as much detail as I think they deserve unless we get significant talus anomalies.

No economic mineralization was spotted but there is some interesting quartz veining on the E side of DIX 1 associated with felsic dykes and limestone. The limestone is quite a bit more extensive than I originally thought, but no evidence of calc-silicates though.

Bon talus sampled all week - 115 samples in 5 days with a sore knee; not too bad.

I'm sending in the finished map and the talus sample sheets. I still owe you a written report for Dixie and the rock sample descriptions. Also outstanding is the location map for the Roman Claims. Maybe if it rains rains all next week I'll get caught up on my paper-work.
