Re : Report on DIX Claims (August, 1982)

Dear Com,

It's finally finished. I've written in in the style indicated under the Mineral Act as required for assessment reports and I hope most of it will be suitable for this purpose. It may be somewhat longwinded for a simple assessment report but I've included the data which I feel will also be of interest to Newex.

I think Au is a lost cause on the property (unless the Corvill Creek talus sample grid produces significant anomalies) but there may be Sn and W potential along the Surprise Butte lith-Cade Creek Group contact. I've leaned the report this way but you're welcome to change it. I also feel that the limestone just east of Lewis Creek should be sampled with the one talus sample taken there last year ~~it~~ should be run for Sn and W (Q1-NXD-CT-17). This ground was staked last year but may come open. However, you'll have to decide if Sn and W are worthwhile targets. The report is missing a location map

which I have referred to as Figure 1. I presume this will be photocopied from a 1:250,000 base map. The data for the tables was taken off of finished geochemistry maps but don't be surprised if I miscounted a few times (eg. there may be a few more or a few less than 474 talus samples).
