HEAGY & AWMACK

Four units (the SAU claim group, tag number 72853) were staked July 30, 1983 to cover a prominent orange Fe-carbonate alteration zone exposed in a small canyon of a creek draining westerly into the Little Blue River. An ~~easterly-trending~~ air photo linear extends ^{roughly east} from the zone exposed in the creek to the ridge-top and is sporadically and weakly altered.

Rock exposure on the SAU claim group is limited to the creek canyon and the eastern edge ^{of the claim.} The rock types are: 1. Andesite tuff (olive-grey, fine-grained, slightly chloritic, with minor pyrite and calcite stringers); 2. Chert (light grey to black, variably argillaceous and phyllitic, with prominent warped bedding (locally interbedded with argillite laminae)); 3. Phyllitic argillite (black, fine-grained, soft, phyllitic). They appear to be interbanded and dip steeply south, but contacts are indeterminate.

Alteration is variable
