

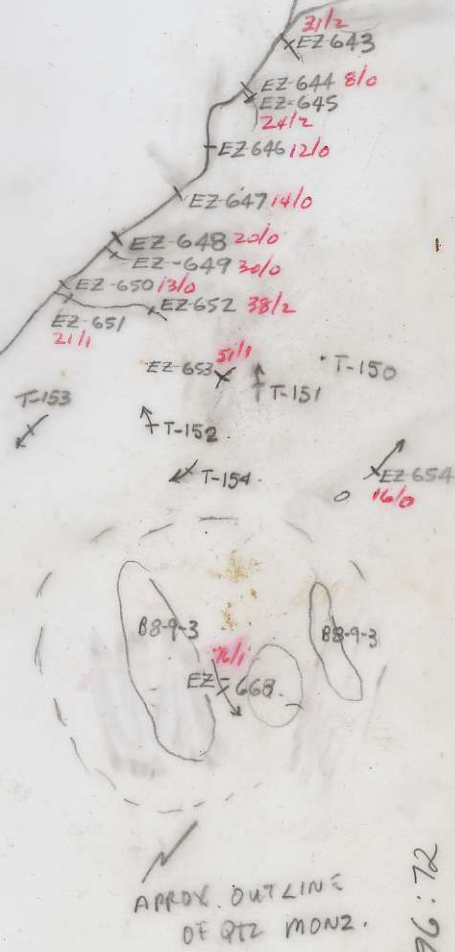

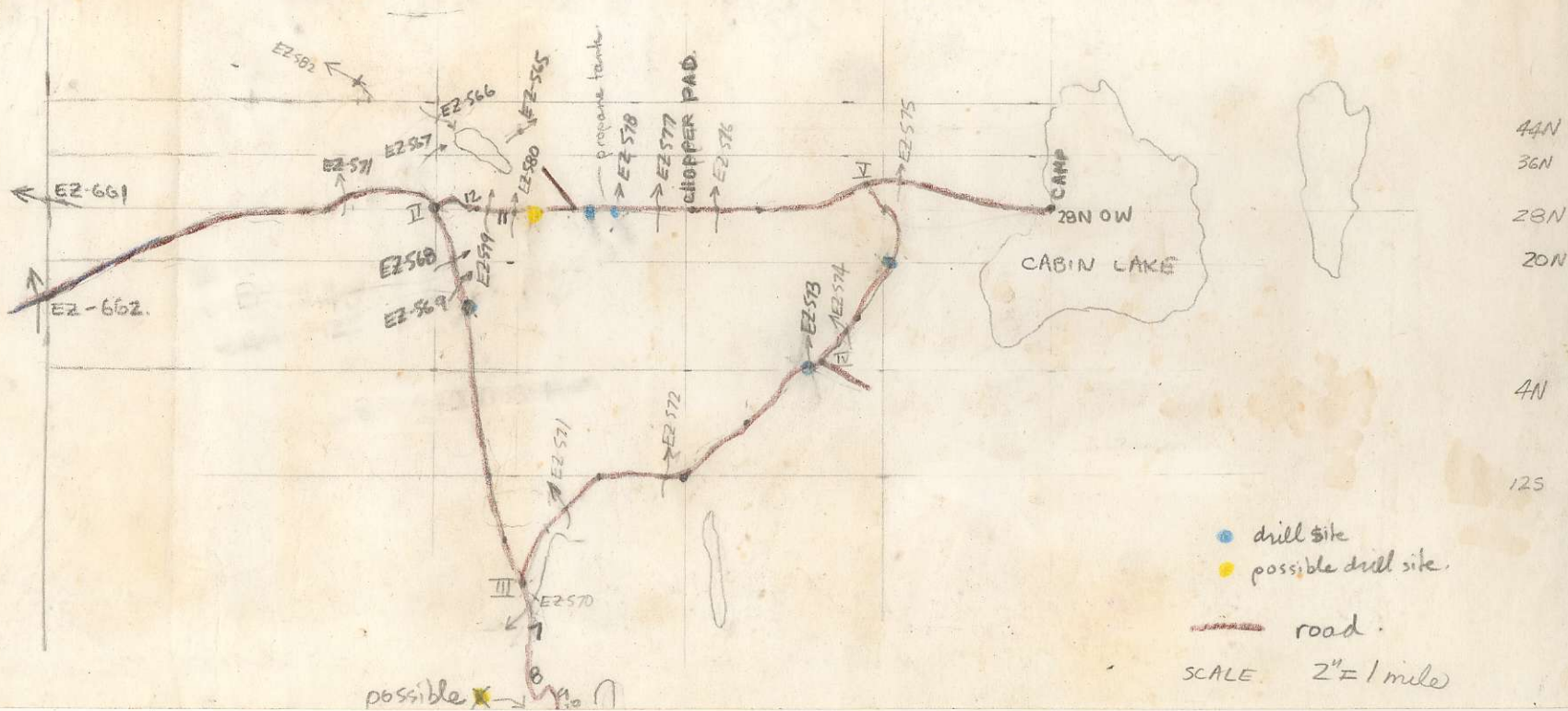

TERRY:

Well, it's all there on the overlays - the usual sitting & mapping (or attempt at same). We located Noranda's Babe claims, their cut lines & quite a few of the drill sites (marked on the clearprint) - 10 holes were drilled (^{200'-400'} deep) (~ 1" diameter core) & the core is at the camp on CABIN LAKE - didn't see all that much BFP in our 10 minute look at the core - noticed some graphite (a foot or two) ~~in~~ in one hole which I.P. might have picked up.

Have staked 8 claims, ^{centered} over the easternmost ridge of the three where we found quite a bit of pyrite (We have written up affidavits - claims can probably be registered on my way out if they are to be - probably a good idea to). Have run three soil lines over the ridges from the east of the graben-like structure at camp here out west to the other side of the central ridge (200' intervals) & two soil traverses (400' intervals) - one to north & one to south - see also "grid" map of claims on clearprint - hope something turns up in lab results.

We ran quite a few samples & no particular patterns but some reasonable - good kicks, especially over the easternmost ridge. Have also tried to sort & classify the rocks a bit better but have still had a bit of trouble ~~with~~ a lot of quartz monzonite with minor pyrite on the western & central ridges, quite a few volcanics (dykes) on the easternmost with some good PY & some ~~very~~ highly altered / weathered / fuched porphyritic rock over on the ridge to the east of camp & to the south. (see overday). The area directly north of camp is overlain by drift & shows very little V.C. - Hope you have a bit better luck at figuring out what's going on than ~~we~~ ^{we} have. Incidentally, there is very definite & concentrated faulting around the ^(over)

easternmost ridge & out east to camp area as we have
found quite a few slicken sides - some well polished.

Thanks very much for the magazines (New Scientist,
